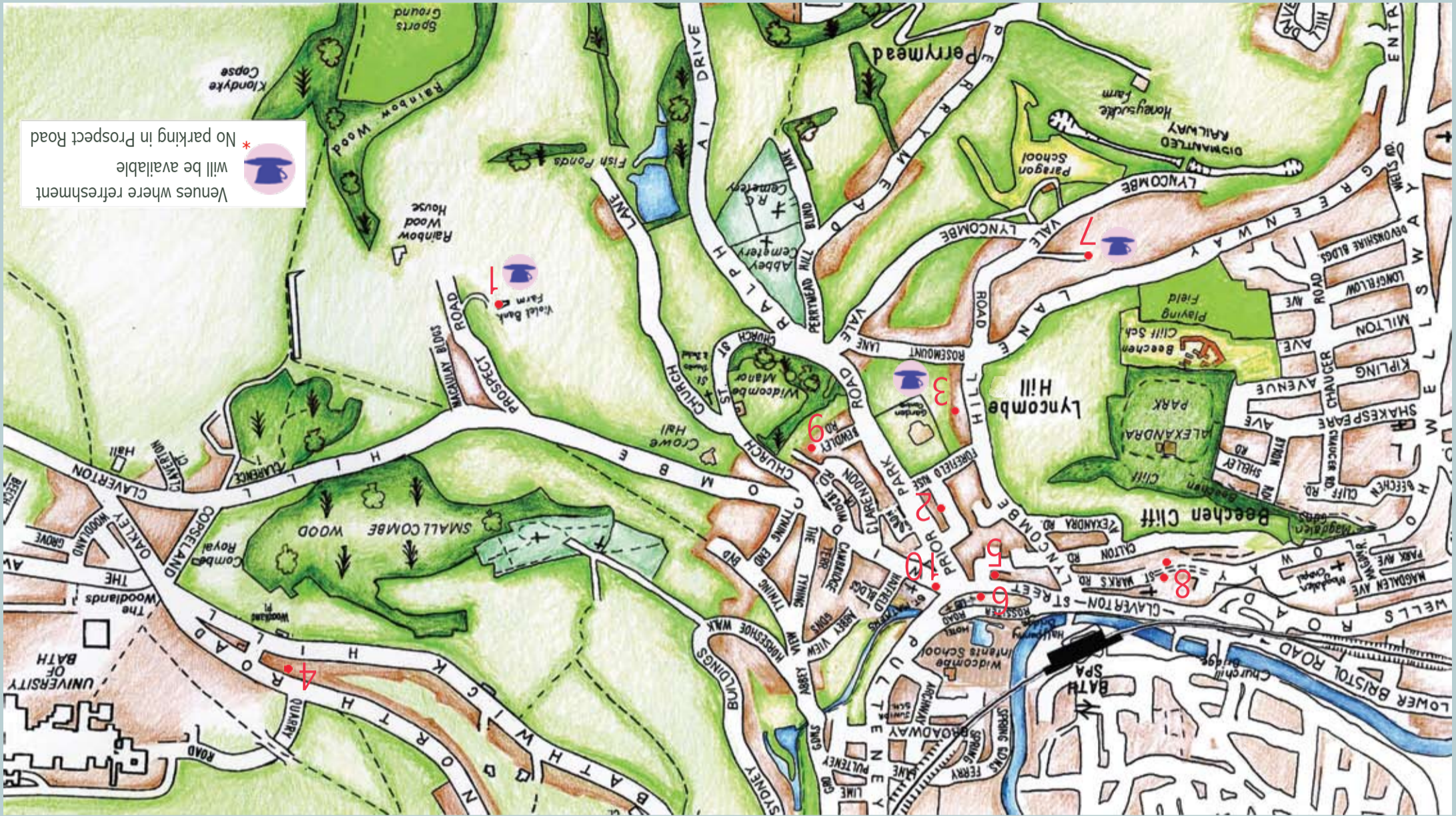

This is Widcombe's third Art Trail, and a wide range of work by local artists will be on show in studios and other venues. These are mostly within easy walking distance from each other. Widcombe, lying just across the river from the city centre is a greener part of Bath, full of historic buildings and attractive walks through hidden leafy lanes and along the canal towpath.

Jane Austen wrote favourably about walks up to Beechen Cliff with its fine views, and by the stream in Lyncombe Vale. Ralph Allen built his mansion at Prior Park with its magnificent garden. The garden is now a National Trust property open to the public. In Claverton Street, the heart of Widcombe, there are a number of specialist shops and places of refreshment well worth visiting.

Directions:

There is some unrestricted parking nearby on Widcombe Hill. Unrestricted parking may be found, for instance on Perrymead, and there is a small car park off Rossiter Road and various 2 hour parking areas. The cricket ground car park by North Parade Bridge is not too distant. Parking is not restricted on Sundays. From the city centre, the centre of Widcombe is easily reached by pedestrians via the Halfpenny Bridge – the footbridge immediately behind the railway station. Or arrive by towpath along the river or canal.
