



Improvements for Widcombe Parade

Between March and November work will be taking place to re-direct A36 through traffic onto Rossiter Road to deliver a more pleasant environment for people on foot and cyclists.

Work to transform Widcombe Parade into a more pleasant environment for people on foot and cyclists will take place from the beginning of March 2014. The scheme is scheduled for completion in November.

The scheme takes A36 through traffic, including HGV's, away from Widcombe Parade and delivers significant improvements to the public realm that will enable the Parade to return to being a vibrant village High Street.



Key Aspects of the Scheme

Widcombe Parade and Pulteney Road South

- 20 mph speed limit and design.
- Widcombe Parade; local traffic one way eastbound.
- Pulteney Road South; two way local traffic.
- Double mini roundabout at junction of Widcombe Parade, Widcombe Hill and Prior Park Road.
- New pedestrian crossings.
- Two way cycling connections.
- Improved bus stops.
- Retained on-street short stay shopper parking.
- Business and surgery drop off bays.
- High quality "conservation" paving.
- Improved built environment, including better pavements.
- New tree planting scheme, including a gateway tree at west end of parade.
- New seating and bike parking.

Rossiter Road

- A36 through traffic two way flow.
- 30 mph speed limit and design.
- New traffic signals at the junction of Rossiter Road and Pulteney Road and west end of Widcombe Parade.
- Improved signal controlled pedestrian and cycle facilities.
- Right turn facility for small vehicles into Lyncombe Hill.
- Station drop-off on Rossiter Road.
- Access to Widcombe Parade Car Park and service area retained.

The Council will provide further information on upcoming work and liaise with local businesses and residents to help ensure inconvenience is minimised throughout the construction period.
