



Q3 Do you agree that there are Traffic problems on Widcombe Hill?





Q4 Concerning vehicles on Widcombe Hill, do any of these issues concern you (tick appropriate boxes)





Q5 Do you think that Widcombe Hill is dangerous for cyclists?





Q6 Do you think that Widcombe Hill Dangerous for pedestrians?




