From its roots as the Widcombe Association's members' newsletter, we have evolved this half yearly publication into a magazine for Widcombe. The content reflects this and profiles people, events, business and community groups from across Widcombe all aiming to promote Widcombe as a vibrant place to live or work.

One of the primary aims is to provide traders with a tailored way to reach out to the people who live and work in Widcombe.

The magazine is run by Widcombe Association volunteers and is funded by the WA. It is a free magazine. Traders have free 1/6th page ads as part of their membership but can buy bigger ads if they wish, which will help fund the magazine. Only WA business members can advertise in the magazine. [although we will commission a limited number of advertorials from businesses from outside Widcombe, but who serve its residents, as long as they don't compete directly with any WA Business members].

We have been steadily increasing the circulation from just members and aim to deliver to most households in Widcombe as well as place copies in local outlets and on-line.
